

The Pilgrim Statues of Our Lady of Fatima have been traveling for many years to spread the message of Fatima throughout the world. On May 13 2010, Pope Benedict XVI said, "At that time it was only three children, yet the

example of their lives spread and multiplied, especially as a result of the travels of the Pilgrim Virgin, in countless groups throughout the world, dedicated to the cause of fraternal solidarity." Mary appeared in Fatima every month from May to October 1917. She delivered a series of messages during that time to three young children, Lúcia dos Santos and her cousins Francisco and Jacinta Marto. While Mary discussed many things with the children, the message of Our Lady of Fatima can be summarized with three invitations:

- 1. Learn to pray the rosary, the prayer that can change the world.
- 2. Get spiritually healthy.
- 3. Let Mary guide you to lasting happiness.
